



Signs That Your Child May Benefit from an Evaluation with an Occupational Therapist

Occupational Therapy Fine Motor

- Is unable to hold a toy in both hands by 10 months
- Is not using a spoon by age 2
- Is not using a fork by age 3
- Is unable to stack 3 blocks by age 3
- Has difficulty holding a crayon or scribbling by 30 months
- Is unable to throw a ball by 30 months
- Is unable to dress self (including zippers, buttons, and fasteners) by age 6
- Has not established hand preference by age 6
- Is unable to tie shoes by age 7
- Has poor handwriting
