



Signs That Your Child May Benefit from an Evaluation with a Speech Therapist

Speech Language Therapy Speech/Language

- Is unable to say certain sounds or imitate sounds
- Has a limited vocabulary (fewer than 15 words by 15-18 months, fewer than 50 words by 24 months)
- Unable to point out body parts on self by 15-18 months
- Stutters or gets stuck on words
- Has trouble regulating loudness of voice
- Repeats words in conversations
- Has difficulty answering questions
- Has difficulty understanding simple commands by 12-15 months
- Has trouble making friends/interacting with peers
- Has excessive drool
- Is a very messy eater
- Has difficulty drinking through a straw by age 2
- Is unable to blow bubbles or whistle
- Does not respond to name or familiar voices
- Cannot shake head “no” by 12-15 months
